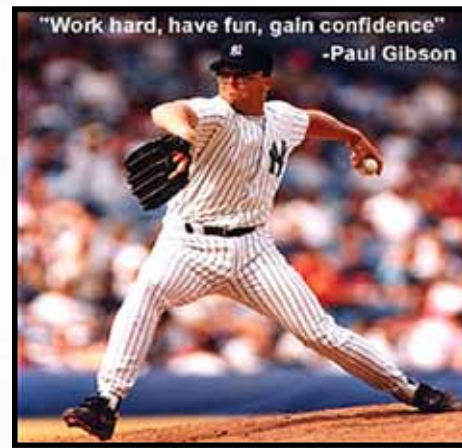

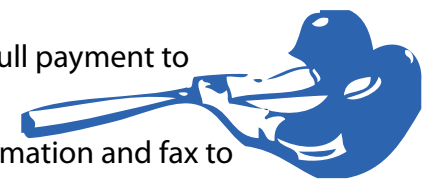
**Rookie Camp: Ages 5-6
